1. Algemene reëls

- 1.1 Slegs aansoeke van studente wat in Graad 12 hierdie jaar is of reeds geregistreer is aan Suid-Afrikaanse openbare tersiëre instellings, of oornemende studente wat in 2024 met hulle studieprogramme gaan begin, en wat woonagtig is in die geografiese gebied van die Noupoort windplaas, sal oorweeg word.
- 1.2 Slegs aansoekvorms sal oorweeg word wat korrek en volledig voltooi is, en vergesel word van die nodige dokumente.
- 1.3 Slegs aansoeke van swart Suid-Afrikaanse burgers sal oorweeg word.
- 1.4 Voltooid aansoekvorms en die nodige dokumente moet op of voor 30 September 2023 ingehandig word by die Windplaas Kantoor of per epos gestuur word aan b.ndlovu@studytrust.org.za.
- 1.5 Dokumente benodig
 - 1.5.1 'n Kopie van u Nasionale Senior Sertifikaat (NSS)
 - 1.5.2 'n Afskrif van u akademiese rekord – indien van toepassing.
 - 1.5.3 Registrasiebewys van die instelling waar u studeer, of 'n aanvaardingsbrief as u voornemens is om in 2024 te begin studeer.
 - 1.5.4 'n Gesertifiseerde kopie van u ID.
 - 1.5.5 Dokumentasie wat die totale maandelikse inkomste van al die lede van u huisgesin bevestig.

2. Keuringskriteria

Die belangrikste kriteria wat aangewend sal word in die keuring van suksesvolle aansoekers vir die Noupoort Windplaas is:

- 2.1 Akademiese uitnemendheid – keuring sal gedoen word op die basis van Graad 12 uitslae en/of 'n volledige tersiëre akademiese rekord.
- 2.2 Finansiële behoefte: aansoekers moet kan bewys dat die gesamentlike bruto gesinsinkomste nie hoër is as R350,000 per jaar nie.

3. Keurproses

'n Beperkte aantal beurse sal toegeken word aan die mees verdienstelike kandidate.

4. Waarde van die Noupoort Windplaas beurs

Die waarde van die beurs sal bepaal word op 'n individuele basis. Die beurs mag gebruik word om die volgende studie-verwante onkoste te dek:

- 4.1 Klasgelder, registrasiefooi en eksamenfooi
- 4.2 Verblyf in 'n universiteitskoshuis of soortgelyke private akkommodasie
- 4.3 Maaltye
- 4.4 Leermateriaal (handboeke, skryfbehoeftes, ens.)

5. Ingehandigde aansoekvorms: ontvangserkenning en terugvoer

- 5.1 Aansoekers sal 'n epos ontvang om te bevestig dat hulle aansoekvorms ontvang is. Alle korrek en volledig ingevulde aansoekvorms vergesel van die vereisde dokumentasie sal oorweeg word.

INFORMATION LETTER

Noupoort Wind Farm invites bursary applications from current students at public South African institutions of higher learning (FETCs, Universities of Technology and Universities). Applicants must live in the geographical area of the Noupoort Wind Farm and must be South African citizens.

Dear Applicant

Please read the instructions before completing the application form.

1. General rules

- 1.1 Only applications from present students at South African public tertiary institutions of higher learning, or students who will commence with their study programmes in January 2024, who live in the geographical area of the Noupoort Wind Farm will be considered.
- 1.2 Only application forms completed correctly, in full and accompanied by the required supporting documents will be considered.
- 1.3 Only applications from Black South African citizens will be considered.
- 1.4 The completed application form and supporting documents must be submitted on or before 30 September 2023 at the Municipal office or sent by email to b.ndlovu@studytrust.org.za.

2. Required Documents

- 2.1 A copy of your National Senior Certificate (NSC).
- 2.2 A transcript of your full academic record – if applicable.
- 2.3 Proof of registration at the institution you are studying at, or of the acceptance letter from the institution where you plan to register in 2024.
- 2.4 A certified copy of your ID document.
- 2.5 Documentation proving the total monthly income of members of your household.

3. Selection Criteria

The main criteria used in the selection of successful applicants to the Noupoort Wind Farm bursary are as follows:

- 3.1 Academic excellence - Selection will be done on the basis of Grade 12 and/or tertiary academic record.
- 3.2 Financial need: Applicants must be able to demonstrate that the combined family income (gross) does not exceed R350,000 p/a.

4. Selection Process

A limited number of bursaries will be allocated to the most deserving candidates in terms of the above criteria.

5. Noupoort Wind Farm Bursary Value

The value of the bursary will be determined on an individual basis and may be used to cover the following study-related cost items:

- 5.1 University tuition fees, registration fees and examination fees
- 5.2 Accommodation in a university residence or equivalent
- 5.3 Meals
- 5.4 Learning materials (textbooks, stationary, etc.)

6. Submitted Application Forms: Acknowledgement of Receipt and Outcome

- 6.1 Receipt: You will receive an email confirming receipt of your completed application form. All properly completed applications received will be considered.
- 6.2 Outcome: You may expect an email to the address provided in your application informing you of the provisional outcome of your application by 21 December.

Conditional Third-party sharing.

- Your bursary may be sponsored by a specific company/donor with specific conditions. Only the above-mentioned information will be shared with any potential or actual bursary sponsors.
- StudyTrust has contracted the services of Devman, an online bursary applications platform to enable you to submit your application online.

Data storage and management. Your information will be stored on the servers of our bursary applications service provider Devman. Devman is POPI Act compliant, and all the requisite measures are taken to ensure that your personal information is secure.
